Attainment

Key Stage 2

We had 72 children in Year 6.

The percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard is a combined measure across three subjects. To be counted towards the measure, a pupil must have a scaled score of 100 or more in reading and maths.

Progress

Last year the DfE has introduced new progress measures for Primary Schools which measures progress from the end of Key Stage 1 to the end of Key Stage 2. For each subject, schools have been awarded with a progress score. If a school has a progress score of zero (0), this means that pupils make progress in line with other pupils across the country who had similar starting points. A score above zero, means that pupils make better progress and below zero means that a pupil progress is not as strong.
