# **Home –School Agreement Policy**

In the term after a child reaches the age of five a home school agreement will be completed requiring the signature of the child, parent or principal carer and a representative of the school.

The home school agreement sets out parents and pupils can expect from the academy and what the academy expects of parents and pupils.

The home school agreement is summarised as follows:

### Mount Pellon Primary Academy aims to:

- Provide a safe, caring, stimulating environment
- Ensure that your child achieves their potential as a valued member of our academy community
- Welcome parents/ carers into the academy to share information
- Provide opportunities for you to become involved in the life of our academy
- Inform parents/carers of children's targets
- Provide a balanced, challenging curriculum
- Celebrate achievements, behaviour and attendance

## Parents/ Carers will try to:

- Ensure that your child attends regularly and is punctual
- Make sure that academy is aware of any concerns or problems that might affect your child's work or behaviour
- Ensure that your child comes to the academy clean, in academy uniform, ready to learn
- Encourage your child to take responsible for their own behaviour
- Support your child with their homework and celebrate their achievements
- Inform the academy of any absence by telephone or letter.

### The Child will try to:

- Remember my book bag, homework and P.E. kit
- Complete my class work to the best of my ability
- Follow my class and academy rules
- Be polite and helpful to everyone in the academy
- Make sure that I complete my homework on time
